The Friends will sponsor a Four Shillings Short concert July 26 at Dragonfly Farm from 2-4 pm.



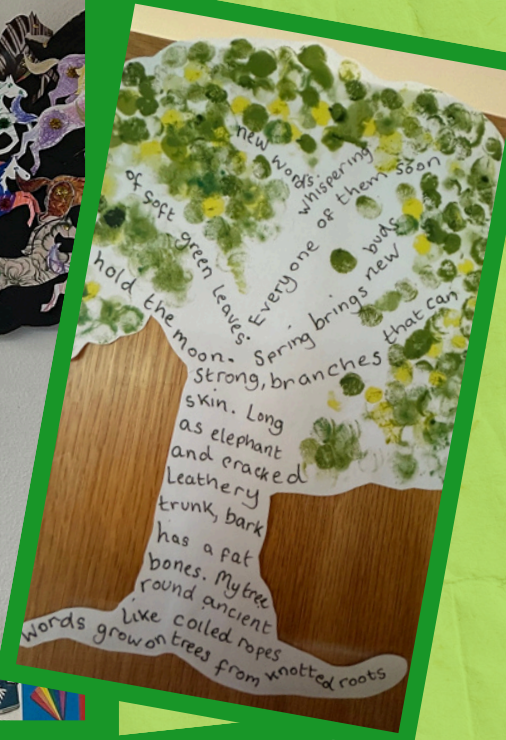
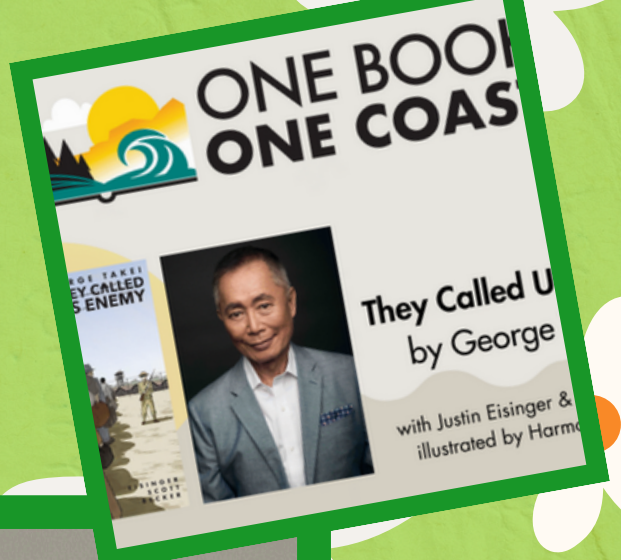
Our staff and patrons colored almost 100 horses for our mighty Year of the Horse stampede!

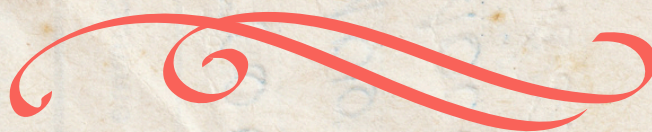
